Glacier Park Lodge

Glacier Park Lodge has 161 guest rooms and employs approximately 250 employees.



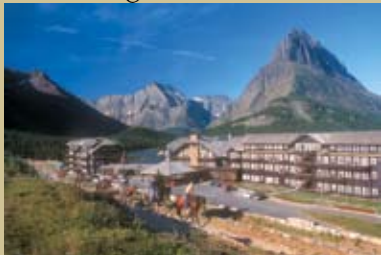
Lake McDonald Lodge

Built in 1914, Lake McDonald Lodge is nestled on the shores of the largest lake in Glacier Park. Two restaurants, lounge, and two retail stores are located at this former hunting lodge. With its enormous fire place and lakeside views, this lodge is a favorite of guests and employees alike. Lake McDonald Lodge has 100 guest rooms and employs approximately 175 employees.



Many Glacier Hotel

Built in 1914, GPI's largest hotel is situated on the shores of Swiftcurrent Lake and rests at the base of Mt. Grinnell and Mt. Shangri-La. The Many Glacier Valley offers some of the best hiking in Glacier National Park. Fine dining, lounge, and 2 retail stores are located within this Swiss-style historic lodge. Many Glacier Hotel has 214 guestrooms and employs approximately 200 employees.

Employment

- Glacier Park, Inc. is an equal opportunity employer.
- You must be 16 years old to work in the state of Montana and you must be 18 years old to live on property. Waitstaff and barstaff must be at least 18 and drivers must be at least 21.
- To work at any U.S. property you must be a citizen of the U.S. or possess the appropriate documentation that will allow you to work in the U.S.
- Appearance and personal hygiene are crucial to the hotel and restaurant business. Our standards are conservative and strictly enforced.
- Meals and lodging are provided for those living in company housing for a nominal fee. Please check with Human Resources for current rate information. Employees returning consecutive seasons receive a 25% discount. Pets are not allowed.
- GPI is a seasonal employer. Our wages and benefits are competitive with other concessioners in the National Parks.
- All employees must be drug-free while on company premises.
- Employment is contingent upon successful completion of a background check.
- All employees serve guests regardless of race, creed, religion, age, sex, veteran status, disability, ancestry, or national origin.
- All employees must provide his/her own transportation to and from Glacier Park.
- Employees are required to pay a \$100 employment agreement deposit refundable upon completion of the employment agreement.

Two Medicine Campstore



This “Mom & Pop” Campstore sits on the shores of Two Medicine Lake in the shadow of Rising Wolf Mountain. Located 12 miles from Glacier Park Lodge, this unique building was once a part of the Two Medicine Chalets. Hiking and boat

tours are readily accessible. Employees are housed at Glacier Park Lodge. Two Medicine Campstore employs approximately 6 people.

Rising Sun Motor Inn



Built in 1940, Rising Sun Motor Inn sits adjacent to spectacular St. Mary Lake and is surrounded by soaring peaks. Two Dog Flats Grill, Campstore, and Gift Shop are available at this centralized location near the East entrance to the

Going-to-the-Sun Road. Hiking, camping, and fishing are all available nearby. Rising Sun Motor Inn has 72 guest rooms and employs approximately 60 employees.

Swiftcurrent Motor Inn



Built in 1933, Swiftcurrent Motor Inn is located on the hillside adjacent to Swiftcurrent Lake and one mile from Many Glacier Hotel. This hiker’s paradise has trailheads leading to Ptarmigan Tunnel, Iceberg Lake, and Swiftcurrent Pass. An Italian-style restaurant

and Campstore are located here. Swiftcurrent Motor Inn has 88 guest rooms and employs approximately 60 people.

Village Inn at Apgar



Built in 1956, Village Inn at Apgar is located on the shores of Lake McDonald. This quaint inn offers stunning views of Stanton Mountain, the Garden Wall and Mt. Brown, as well as easy access to the beach. Employees are housed at

Lake McDonald Lodge. Village Inn at Apgar has 36 guest rooms and staffs approximately 10 people.
